## Hunt Packing List

Due to floatplane weight limitations, we recommend packing as lightly as practical, generally limiting gear to a carry-on sized backpack, 1 checked bag, and a rifle or bow case with ammunition in accordance with airline and TSA regulations. Please contact us with any questions regarding firearms, ammunition, or gear recommendations. Firearms can also be provided upon request.

- Waterproof Outerwear** – High-quality waterproof jacket and pants suitable for hunting conditions are strongly recommended.
- Layered Clothing** – Base layers, fleece or wool mid-layers, warm jacket, and durable hunting or hiking pants are recommended. Merino wool and synthetic layers perform especially well in Alaska conditions. Avoid cotton when possible.
- Hunting Boots** – Knee-high rubber boots with a quality hiking sole are often ideal for wet conditions, though waterproof hiking boots with good ankle support also work well. All guest cabins are equipped with boot warmers for drying boots overnight.
- Warm Accessories** – Bring warm waterproof gloves, a beanie or warm cap, and several pairs of extra wool socks. Backup dry layers and extra socks are especially appreciated in wet conditions.
- Daypack** – A comfortable small-to-medium backpack for carrying water, layers, optics, and personal items during the hunt.
- Optics & Accessories** – Binoculars are strongly recommended. Sunglasses are helpful in bright conditions on the water. Bring a flashlight or headlamp for early mornings & evenings.
- Indoor Shoes or Slippers** – In Alaska, we remove shoes at the front door of our buildings.
- Toiletries & Personal Items** – Please bring all medications, tobacco products, toiletries, and other personal effects. We provide small shampoo, conditioner, and soap amenities, but we do not have a store on the premises.
- Motion Sickness Medication** – Recommended for guests prone to seasickness or motion sickness during boat travel.
- Alcohol** – Limited beer and wine are provided during evening meals. Guests wanting additional alcohol or specific selections should purchase them in Kodiak the evening prior to departure.
